(A) Ezechiel Pfeiffer was born as "Pfeiffer ben Marx". Around 1824 (or probably even before) he adopted "Pfeiffer" as last name for his family and called himself "Ezechiel Pfeiffer", according to the king's order that Jewish families had to adopt last names.

(B) Ezechiel Pfeiffer's father was Marx Anschel (traditionally named

Mordechai Cohen Zedek), who became a Court Jew for the Count of Hohenlohe in Weikersheim in 1761, built a new synagogue in Weikersheim in 1768 and died there in 1780.

(C) Samuel Neckarsulmer (ca 1735 Neckarsulm - 3 Mar 1788 Fuerth)lived in Fuerth since ca 1758. Head of Jewish community until ca 1785. He was a trader in various goods, later in life in partnership with son Moses. His first wife was Hanna Lichtenstaedter, his second wife (married before 1764) was Heffele Gidean, daughter of Koschmann Gidean. She passed away in Fuerth 9 Oct 1801.

(D) Weikersheim birth records give birth date of Marx as 16 Aug 1786, his familysheet in Stuttgart shows his birth date as 25 Jul 1787.

(E) Jakob Raphael Kaulla was Madame Kaulla's brother. Michle Kaulla was Madame Kaulla's daughter.

(F) Wolf Kaulla was Madame Kaulla's son.

(G) Maier Kaulla was another son of Madame Kaulla.
